1.1. Purpose of Policy

3.1. What Does Company Do With Collected Information?

Traffic and transaction information may also be shared with business partners and advertisers on an aggregate and anonymous basis.
- (c) USE OF COOKIES. Promotions or advertisements displayed on our site may contain cookies.
- (d) DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION. We don't share your personal information with anyone except to comply with the law, develop our services, or protect our rights.
